

Our Vision

IN 1983

A decade after Roe v. Wade made abortion legal across the United States, the first Colorado Springs Pregnancy Center was launched with a goal to serve abortion-vulnerable women in our city. In our first year, we reached more than 300 women.

Ensure students and youth in our community know they are valuable and make healthy relationship decisions that reflect their tremendous value.



Education for a Lifetime leads the *Prevention* portion of our mission by educating students on healthy relationships, suicide prevention, and mental health awareness.

Education for a Lifetime also works with the Colorado Springs faith community to promote healthy relationships through *Parent Talks* at churches and Youth Mental Health First Aid trainings.

VALUABLE HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS

Helping Students Make Healthy Choices

The *Pursue* program teaches sexual risk avoidance and how to set healthy boundaries that reflect each student's value. These classes provide medically accurate guidance on teen pregnancy, address highrisk behaviors (such as premarital sexual activity), and prepare students for healthy, long-term relationships.

SUICIDE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION

Empowering Students to Know Their Value

Who Can Relate challenges students to consider those who need them, who love them, and where they find their value. The program seeks to remove the stigma surrounding conversations on mental health and suicide. As students reflect on their worth, their risk of suicide decreases, and their likelihood of healthy choices increases.

Westside Center
Located on Centennial Road, blocks from Planned Parenthood.

Fountain Valley Center
Located on Widefield Blvd.

Eastside Center
Located in Falcon, near the intersection of Woodmen Road and Meridian Road.

Every day, our Colorado Springs Pregnancy Centers meet women and men facing unplanned pregnancies. In their time of need we provide free medical services in conjunction with compassionate, non-judgmental care and promise future support. We empower our patients to make life-affirming choices for their families.



considering abortion before they came to us. With life-saving ultrasounds, you make it possible for nearly two-thirds of them to change their minds.

During every initial patient appointment in our pregnancy centers, we discuss the implications of all three options a woman may be considering.



Parenting

Through the miracle of ultrasound and education on fetal development, we help our patients with a positive pregnancy test understand and embrace the reality of their baby's life. We work to address any concerns they may have about their parenting journey and provide access to resources and our supportive programs. We empower new parents to choose life.



Adoption

Choosing to make an adoption plan helps many women regain stability in their personal lives and creates a positive future for their children. We help our clients understand that adoption can be an incredible, redemptive and selfless choice. We work with several local adoption agencies that will send an agent to our centers to meet directly with our patients and form an adoption plan.



Abortion

Our centers do not perform or refer for abortion but more than half of our patients arrive at our centers considering that option. We believe these women deserve access to medically accurate information from a source that does not benefit in any way from their decision. We provide women with the unbiased truth of what abortion procedures entail, including the physical, emotional, and spiritual risks.

Jessi's story


When Jessi* became pregnant, her boyfriend put pressure on her to have an abortion. She came to our clinic not knowing what to do. Our staff talked with her about different options and gave her several resources. When Jessi left, she refused the prenatal vitamins and information packet.

But she did come back with her boyfriend for the free ultrasound. When they arrived, they told us they had decided to have an abortion. But after the ultrasound, she marked "undecided" on the exit survey.

Two days later, she returned alone. She requested the prenatal vitamins and told us, "Your patient advocate was amazing. She prayed for me. Since the ultrasound, I've been having nightmares about abortion. I kept staring at the packet of resources you gave me and realized that it wasn't impossible to have the baby. After all, I was not alone. I can do this."

She continued, "God has a plan, and I'm letting Him take the wheel. I've been praying, and He opened my eyes. I'm keeping this baby."

Jessi has received prenatal care through our Initial Pregnancy Care services and is interested in joining the parenting coaching team. Because of your ministry partnership Jessi now knows that she is not alone in her pregnancy.




Saving Lives on the East Side

Life Network Is Expanding East

Our community's east side is the fastest-growing area in El Paso County. To ensure easy access to our life-giving services, we purchased a building strategically located across from the busiest Walmart in the area.

Beginning fall of 2024, this fourth pregnancy center and second Thrift Store will provide Life Network's services to the booming east side of our community, expanding the eternal impact that partners like you make possible.

Providing Vital Support Through the Parenthood Program

Many families facing difficult pregnancy decisions in our community consider abortion due to challenging life circumstances: financial need, previous trauma, relationship instability, or fear. We provide continuing support and mentorship through the **Parenting** Program. This program empowers and equips our clients as they build their families and points them toward hope in Christ.

Each Parenthood Program participant can receive:

- One-on-one coaching with a mentor until their child turns two.
- Lessons addressing topics such as pregnancy, infant care, nutrition and childbirth.
- Earn while you learn "baby buck" credits for material resources ranging from baby clothes to bottles to car seats, cribs and more.
- Extra care classes like CPR and finance basics.
- Discipleship and integrated community support during and after the program.





Finding Relational Healing and Freedom from Anger

Mia* received professional counseling for anger and anxiety. She confided that she was involved in several complicated relationships, including a husband who was neglecting his family, an emotionally abusive mother, and an extramarital affair. Through counseling and meetings with her Motherhood coach, Mia decided to end the affair and begin couples' marriage counseling, and learned effective ways to communicate with her mother. Because of these support channels, Mia's marriage has taken a turn toward healing, and she is learning how to manage her anger. By God's grace, and with the comprehensive support she's received, Mia now has far less anxiety and renewed hope for her future.

Bridges of Hope helps women and men process and grieve past abortions. Our group for women is a nine-week healing and support class that uses Biblical principles as tools for healing.

This year, Bridges of Hope offered six Bible-based support groups for men and women seeking healing from abortion. "For the first time in my life, I can freely talk with a group of like-minded and like-suffering women about the most traumatic and awful thing in my life that has held me back from receiving the fullness of God's grace and mercy for far too long. I am hopeful that this study will not only transform my life, but my marriage, other relationships, and most importantly, my relationship with God."

SHARING

the Gospel

Patient advocates are trained to share the gospel message sensitively, appropriately, and truthfully. On a typical day, we have conversations with 12 clients about Christian faith in our centers. In a typical month, we see 8 clients make decisions to follow Christ.

Finding a New Faith and a New Church

Like many of our patients, Kaelyn* felt overwhelmed by her pregnancy because she did not feel like she had the financial resources she needed to support a baby. She felt warmly welcomed by our pregnancy center staff, who provided her with a list of local resources and encouraged her spiritually. "I'm religious," Kaelyn told her patient advocate, "But I do not know God personally."

With permission, the patient advocate was able to explain how Kaelyn could have this personal faith. Kaelyn invited Christ into her life and was given a New Believer Gift Bag and Study Bible. Shortly after this happened, Kaelyn's husband entered the exam room, where he learned of Kaelyn's new faith. "I also believe in God," he said, "and I would like to start going to church." The patient advocate gave the couple a *Looking for a Church?* brochure with a list of local churches, and together, they have begun a new life in Christ.

Kaelyn is one of 103 patients and clients who have decided to follow Christ this year.


